For those who have upcoming surgeries, we understand that you have made preparations, therefore, surgeries are continuing as scheduled.

For patients with follow up visits, we are seeing recent post –operative patients or those with immediate concerns. For those with surgery follow up appointments more than 6 weeks post op with no concerns, we advise to reschedule your appointment.

At this time, we are only allowing the patient into the treatment/ consult rooms. No other guests will be allowed.

Once you arrive to our office and check in at the front desk, we will ask you to please wait in your vehicle until being notified via text.

All patients' temperatures will be taken upon arrival. If a low grade fever is recorded, we will happily reschedule your appointment. Any patients with recent travel from Europe, China, Iran, Korea, New York, Washington, California and Massachusetts will be asked to reschedule their appointment.

Helpful tips to stay healthy for this outbreak and during and cold/flu season:

- Avoid touching your face, particularly your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Wash your hands often and thoroughly.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with your elbow
- Avoid crowded places where infection is more likely to spread
